“GOD’S WILL IS DONE FOR YOU”

What had the disciples experienced in the 24 hours prior to our text?

- *“Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you” (John 6:27).*
- *“Sir, from now on give us this bread” (John 6:34).*

READ: John 6:35-40

Why were the people focusing on their physical needs?

- *“You have seen me and still you do not believe” (36).*

Where is your focus?

How does Jesus redirect your focus?

- *“I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty” (35).*
- *“For I have come down from heaven not to do my own will but to do the will of him who sent me” (38).*

- *“God’s will is done when he breaks and defeats every evil plan and purpose of the devil, the world, and our sinful flesh, which try to prevent us from keeping God’s name holy and letting his kingdom come.” (Luther’s explanation to the 3rd petition)*

How would you define God’s will?

- *“My Father’s will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life” (40).*
- *“[God] wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth” (1 Timothy 2:4).*
